The eSeries will feature six weekly leadership sessions, each with a different guest speaker. Each session will run for about 60 minutes. In addition, you will be matched with other participants to form a leadership 'pod', providing support and learning as you prepare for, or reflect on, each session. ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION

The scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of their application. In addition, eligible applicants must:

- be a current member of WIS SA at the time of applying
- reside in South Australia
- be employed within the superannuation or wider financial services industries
- be able to participate in each of the eSeries sessions from 1 July to 5 August 2020, if successful
- submit a completed application form by the deadline.

All applicants will be reviewed by the WIS SA scholarship selection panel. The final decision regarding the selection of the successful applicants will be at the discretion of the panel. The panel will not be required to give reasons for its decision to any applicant.

The scholarship prize (registration to participate in the Newday 2020 Reimagining Leadership eSeries) is non-transferrable and applicants acknowledge they have no entitlement to any alternative prize in the event the whole or any part of the eSeries does not run for any reason outside of WIS SA's control.

FAQs

What will the selection panel be looking for?

The panel will be looking for applicants who meet the eligibility criteria and best respond to the question why you would like to participate in the Reimagining Leadership eSeries, and the benefits that participation will have for your personal and professional development.

Who is on the selection panel?

The panel will consist of representatives from the WIS SA Committee, including the Chair. Please note that all applications are assessed with names redacted, to ensure a fair voting system.

Will I have to attend an interview?

No. The panel will consider and make their decision based on written applications only.

When will I know if I have been successful?

The five scholarship recipients will be notified via email by Wednesday, 24 June 2020.
